The NCLEX-RN national passing standard was raised April 1, 2013 from -0.16 to 0.00 logits. The new passing standard will remain in effect through March 31, 2016.

Data is based on aggregate results from National Council of State Boards of Nursing and may contain errors due to miscoding by candidates. Current pass rates should be obtained from the program directly.
